The consulting services (“the Services”) includes but not limited to: (i) Conduct Training Need Assessment (TNA), Recommend Training Need, Develop Training Manuals including presentation slide using MS PowerPoint or any other related program and trainer's guide , Organize Training Programs, prepare Budget for Training, Conduct Training, Support PMU for any other human resource development activities within the program, such as Workshops, Seminars, Meetings, discussions etc. (ii) Closely Monitor training execution in the program area throughout the Bangladesh.
