Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI)
For
National Consulting Firms

1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a grant from IFAD's (International Fund for Agricultural Development) Adaptation for Smallholder Agriculture Program (ASAP) Trust fund (ASAP Trust Grant No: G-COFIN-ASP-847A-BD) for the Haor Infrastructure and Livelihood Improvement Project (HILIP) including Climate Adaptation and Livelihood Protection (CALIP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to cover eligible payment under the contract for the provision of consultancy service for the project by a consulting firm (national) on Develop Pro-Poor Adaptation Pathways Framework for the Haor Region in Bangladesh.
2. The objective of the overall assignment is to develop a Framework for pro-poor adaptation pathways with a detailed guideline to aid decision making and designing development programs for implementing pro-poor adaptation strategies in the Haor Basin".
3. HILIP now invites eligible consultants (Firms) to express their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (List of similar assignments, list of key personnel and so on). The expert/specialist required to carry out the assignment are team leader (Senior Climate Change Expert) and other Agriculture, fisheries, Socio-economic related to the above activities. Applicable method will be Fixed Budget Selection (FBS).
4. Consulting firm's qualification and experiences:
 - The firm should be legally registered and must have 05 years of experiences in socio economic and climate studies in Bangladesh under development projects;
 - The firm should have successfully completed at least one service contract related to climate change related study within the last 3 years;
 - The firm should have experience in working with donor funded projects (WB, UN financed project would be desirable);
 - Working experience in Haor/Char land/Costal areas and evidence of undertaking similar assignments and production of quality results will be an advantage.
 - The firm should provide undertaking that the firm has not been blacklisted or debarred by any Government Organization;
 - A capacity statement on available IT equipment (software/hardware) requirement for data analysis process;
5. The interested consulting firm shall submit their EOIs including, but not limited to, the following information:

A. General information of the organization:

- (i) Name and address with Organization's Brochure; and
- (ii) Number of years in active business (with supporting legal/relevant documents).

B. Mandatory information of the organization:

- (i) Updated Trade license and Registration number with year and name of the agency;
- (ii) TIN and VAT Registration number;
- (iii) Total number of permanent staff in pay- roll (i.e. in tabular form) with their qualification.
- (iv) Average Annual Turnover for last 3 FYs supported by Audit Financial reports;
- (v) Number of similar contracts with value completed in last 5 FYs only; and
- (vi) List of works conducted in Haor/Costal/Char areas.
- (vii) Experience in development partner's funded similar projects;
- (viii) List of offices/training centres/workshops with address/areas in square feet and list of logistics.
