**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (REOI)
(CONSULTING SERVICES- FIRMS SELECTION)**

The Government of Bangladesh (GoB) has applied for financing from the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of the Integrated Solid Waste Management Improvement Project (ISWMIP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include detailed feasibility study (including technical, economic and financial, legal, social, and environmental aspects), detailed design, and cost estimates, social and environmental safeguards issues and construction supervision, monitoring, and contract management for the subprojects under the Integrated Solid Waste Management Improvement Project (ISWMIP). The main objective of the ISWMIP is to improve solid waste management services in selected urban local bodies (ULBs).

The consultancy package will involve anticipated 180 person-months of national key experts. The implementation period is October 2024 – September 2028. The expected start date of the assignment is October 2024.

The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Management Competence [Quality of Firm's (Standard policies, procedures, and practices)]
- Technical Competence [The Consultant must have completed at least two similar assignments (project management includes preparation, design and supervision of urban development project which involves solid waste management component) within the last ten years.]
- Geographic Competence [Firm's regional experience (South Asia)]



Consultants should submit EOI in standard template (available for download from web address:

- a. Cover Letter signed by authorized signatory with name(s), address(es), contact details of partners / associates (if any),
- b. Letter of Intent to form a JV or Agreement of Joint Venture or Association or Partnership with clear indication of share of responsibility and business (if applicable),
- c. Additional information / documentation on the following (documentary evidence to be attached):
 - ✓ Legal Status (Firm's Registration Certificate);
 - ✓ Company Profile including management, personnel, firm's specialty, performance;
 - ✓ The latest annual report;
 - ✓ Details of experience in similar assignments undertaken, including value of consulting services and value of works, location, number of staff involved in the contract, name of the Client, name of partners for contract execution and share of services, source of financing, type of services provided, contract commencement and completion dates, brief description of the contract;

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section II, paragraph 4.4, and paragraph 4.9 of the AIB's "Procurement Instructions for Recipients" June 2, 2016, setting forth the AIB's policy on conflict of interest and eligibility.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Instructions for Recipients.
